Ouachita Hills Academy offers some classes (science, history, and so/jr Bible) on a rotating year basis. On years beginning with an odd number, Science of the Physical Creation, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology/ Health, American History, and Pauline Epistles are offered. On years beginning with an even number, Biology, Physics, World History, and Daniel & Revelation are offered. These would be the typical classes (not including Vocational Classes) that students would be in.
